

Knitted twiddlemuff

Twiddlemuffbody without lining

1 strand of wool

Cast on 60 stitches with 3,5 mm circular or straight needles

Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 2 to 2,5 inches

Continue with stocking stitch 9 to 11 inches. You can knit entirely in a single color, or change the color/ use up oddments of various textures of wool such as chunky, mohair, ribbon etc

Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 2 to 2,5 inches

Cast off stitches

Chunky wool or 2 strands of double knitting wool

Cast on 40 stitches with 6 mm circular or straight needles

Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 2 to 2,5 inches

Continue with stocking stitch 9 to 11 inches. You can knit entirely in a single color, or change the color/use up oddments of various textures of wool such as chunky, mohair, ribbon etc

Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 2 to 2,5 inches

Cast off stitches



Twiddlemuffbody without lining and decoration

Decoration:

You can decorate the muff, inside and out, with ribbons, beads, flowers, pompoms, bells, buttons, zips, loops etc. You can also knit or crochet

- a separate pocket for a favourite photo or a handkerchief with a drop of favorite perfume
- applique figures; animals, houses, cars, trees etc.
- amigurumi figures; little teddy bears, bunnies, cats, dogs etc.
- head and tail for dog or cat twiddlemuff

Be creative, but make sure each item is securely attached!

Croched head (1 strand of wool)

Worked in the round in a circle on hook size 4 mm. Start at the tip on snout by making a MAGIC CIRCLE

MAGIC CIRCLE:

When piece is worked in the round, start with this technique to avoid hole in the middle (instead of ch-ring): Hold the yarn end and wind the yarn one time around the index finger to make a loop. Hold the loop with left thumb and middle finger place the yarn over left index finger. Insert hook through the loop, make a YO and pull yarn through loop, work 1 ch, then work dc around the loop. When the desired no of dc have been reached, pull the yarn end to tighten the loop. Fasten the yarn end at the back. Continue to work in the round in a circle.

ROUND 1: Work 6 dc in the magic circle. READ WORK IN THE ROUND IN A CIRCLE!

ROUND 2: Work 2 dc in every dc = 12 dc.

ROUND 3: * 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc *, repeat from *-* the entire round = 18 dc.

ROUND 4: * 1 dc in each of the next 2 dc, then 2 dc in next dc *, repeat from *-* the entire round = 24 dc.

ROUND 5: * 1 dc in each of the next 3 dc, then 2 dc in next dc *, repeat from *-* the entire round = 30 dc.

ROUND 6-13: Work 1 dc in every dc = 30 dc.

ROUND 14 : * 1 dc in each of the next 3 dc, then 1 dc in next 2 dc *, repeat from *-* the entire round = 24 dc.

ROUND 15: Work 1 dc in every dc =24 dc.

ROUND 16: * 1 dc in each of the next 2 dc, then 1 dc in next 2 dc *, repeat from *-* the entire round = 18 dc.

ROUND 17: Work 1 dc in every dc =18 dc.

ROUND 18: * 1 dc in 1 dc, then 1 dc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *-* the entire round = 12 dc.

ROUND 19: Work 1 dc in every dc =12 dc.

ROUND 20: *1 dc in 2 dc*, repeat from *-* the entire round = 6 dc.

ROUND 21: *1 dc in 2 dc*, repeat from *-* the entire round = 3 dc.

EARS:

Worked back and forth on hook size 3,5 mm.

ROW 1: Beg at the bottom of ear, work 4 ch, then 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc in next ch, 2 dc in last ch = 5 dc, turn.

ROW 3-6: Work 1 dc in every dc = 5 dc, turn

ROW 7: 1 dc in next 2 dc, 1 dc, 1 dc in 2 next dc= 3 dc

ROW 8: 1 dc in 2 dc, 1 dc = 2 dc

Fasten off

Work another ear the same way.

Sew ears on each side of head.



Place the eyes (glass eye badge or black buttons) on each side of head

Place t a black button as the End of muzzle

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Knitted sensory wristband/ twiddlemuff for kids with Adhd, autism or visual impairment

Sensory wristband/Twiddlemuffbody for a kid

1 strand of wool

Cast on 40 stitches with 3,5 mm straight needles
Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 1 inches
Continue with stocking stitch 4 to 4,5 inches
Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 1 inches
Cast off stitches



Chunky wool or 2 strands of double knitting wool

Cast on 28 stitches with 6 mm straight needles
Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 1 inches
Continue with stocking stitch 4 to 4,5 inches
Knit one right, one inside, one right ... 1 inches
Cast off stitches



Decoration:

You can decorate the muff with ribbons, beads, flowers, pompoms, bells, buttons, but also with knitted or crocheted head and tail (see cat and dog muffs ahead) or amigurumi figure
Be creative, but make sure each item is securely attached!

Croched head (Chunky wool or 2 strands of double knitting wool)

Worked in the round in a circle on hook size 4 mm. Start at the tip on snout by making a MAGIC CIRCLE

MAGIC CIRCLE:

When piece is worked in the round, start with this technique to avoid hole in the middle (instead of ch-ring): Hold the yarn end and wind the yarn one time around the index finger to make a loop. ROUND 1: Work 6 dc in the magic circle. READ WORK IN THE ROUND IN A CIRCLE!

ROUND 2: Work 2 dc in every dc = 12 dc.

ROUND 3: * 1 dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc *, repeat from *-* the entire round = 15 dc.

ROUND 4-6: Work 1 dc in every dc = 15 dc.

ROUND 7: * 1 dc in next 3 dc, 1 dc in 2 next dc *, repeat from *-* the entire round = 12 dc.

ROUND 8: Work 1 dc in every dc = 12 dc.

ROUND 9: *1 dc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *-* the entire round = 6 dc.

ROUND 10: *1 dc in next 2 dc*, repeat from *-* the entire round = 3 dc.

ROUND 11: 1 dc in next 2 dc, 1dc in next 2 dc.

Fasten off

EARS:

Worked back and forth on hook size 3,5 mm.

ROW 1: Beg at the bottom of ear, work 4 ch, then 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 dc in last 2 ch = 4 dc, turn.

ROW 2: 1 dc in 2nd dc from hook, 1 dc in next 2 dc= 3 dc, turn

ROW 3: 1 dc in 2nd dc from hook, 1 dc in next dc= 2 dc, turn

ROW 4: 1 dc in 2 dc = 1 dc

Fasten off

Work another ear the same way.

Sew ears on each side of head.

Place the eyes (glass eye badge or black buttons) on each side of head

Do the End of muzzle from strand of wool
